TO BECOME A POLL WORKER!

Get paid to do a good thing!

Why?

- **You can earn \$225** for working on Election Day and attending the mandatory training class!
- Your community needs more people like you to work the polls on Election Day.
- Poll Workers play a vital role in the election process.
- It's also an opportunity to meet new people and have fun working!
- It's a resume builder!

Main Requirements:

- You must be a U.S. citizen.
- You must be 18 years of age by the General Election.
- You must be a registered voter in Boone County (and have not changed your party affiliation in the past year).
- You must attend a scheduled training class.

It's Easy to Do!

- First requirement for all poll workers is to attend a mandatory two-hour training class for your particular assignment. There are four positions available at each precinct, and if selected, your assignment is determined by the Boone County Board of Elections.
- On Election Day you will arrive early before the polls open to ensure your precinct is set up and ready for the doors to open at 6:00AM.
- You will sign in voters, provide them with the appropriate ballot, and make sure they cast their ballot properly.
- At 6:00PM you and your fellow poll workers will close the poll and ensure that the polling place is left in the same manner as when you arrived.
